Official Show Rules

1. This show is held in strict accordance with the latest and revised Official Show Rules of the American Rabbit Breeders Association, Inc.
2. All rabbits must be permanently marked in the left ear prior to showing. An ARBA licensed registrar will be available for ear marks as well as ARBA registrations.
3. Exhibitors are responsible to make sure their rabbits are taken to the judging area when called. Absolutely no refund of entry fees will be made.
4. Awards must be picked up the day of the show. Legs are mailed within 30 days of the show.
5. All animals must be healthy and in proper-size transport cages to ensure rabbits' well-being.
- 6. Parents - children must be under the supervision of an adult at all times.**
7. The club and/or its officers are not liable for any injury or damage in connection with the show.
8. Exhibitors must clean their area when leaving; otherwise a fine may be imposed.
9. Youth may not enter the same animal in both open and youth, but they may enter different animals in open and in youth.
10. Any issue arising that cannot be resolved by reference to the above rules shall be decided by the official show committee, whose decision will be final.

1. **OWNERSHIP: EXHIBITOR MUST OWN MARKET ANIMALS 60 CONSECUTIVE DAYS PRIOR TO APRIL 7, 2010.**
2. Minimum market weight will be 2 pounds. Maximum weight is 5 pounds. Any animals weighing over 5 pounds will be sifted and not be allowed to show.
3. All rabbits must have a permanent tattoo that corresponds with the entry form.
4. **PREMIUM MONEY IS NOT OFFERED IN MARKET DIVISIONS.**
5. Exhibitors must wear official 4-H, FFA, Grange or Independent Uniforms while carrying rabbits. All organizations will show in the same classes.
6. No Carriers will be provided. Unless prior permission has been received from the Stock Show Manager, all exhibitors **MUST** carry their own rabbits to the judging table.
7. The Supreme and Reserve Supreme Champion Market Meat Pen and Single Fryer Awards will be presented at the awards ceremony. In the event the exhibitor does not attend, the award will be withheld.
8. **All Market Rabbits must weigh in on Saturday, April 7 at 8:30 AM.** Judging will immediately follow.

1. 4-H and FFA exhibitors will compete in the same classes.
2. Late entries will be accepted between 8 and 9 AM on Saturday, April 6 at the check in table. Late entry fee will apply.
3. Any exhibitor having one or more entries in the rabbit show is eligible to compete.
4. Animals shown in showmanship MUST BE owned, entered and shown by the exhibitor in the rabbit show.
5. Exhibitors must wear Official 4-H, FFA, Grange, or Independent uniform while competing in this showmanship. Long sleeves are required.
6. Exhibitor's age is determined as of January 1, 2010.
7. Showmanship will be held at the Breeding Rabbit Show on Saturday, April 6.
8. Division and Class MUST be indicated on the entry form.
9. Winners of each class are not eligible to move to the next class.
