Checks or Money Orders must accompany entries – If you enter, entries must be paid; even if you don't come!!!

Substitutions: (Ear Changes Only) Same Breed, Sex, & Variety, may be made at the table on the day of the show before judging. It is the exhibitors' responsibility to make LEGIBLE changes!

Changes in class, sex, variety will not be tolerated: To change class, sex, or variety a fee of \$5 per rabbit per show will be applied, Please fill out the yellow form indicating the change. Any exhibitor attempting to make changes other than ear numbers without authorization from the show secretary will be subject to having the rabbit scratched.

Please bring a Raffle Item – The club raffle helps offset expenses and keeps entry fees from going up

Bring a copy of your email entry and conformation, If you do not receive a confirmation you are not entered in the show, and you will be charged \$5 per rabbit per show.

Please list whether you are entering in Open or Youth, and include Phone #, & Email Address

If you plan to register your rabbit, please bring:

ARBA membership Card, FULL 3 generation pedigree (all blanks filled in)
Make sure the rabbit has a legible tattoo(s). If not see the Show Registrar, to get it done.

Show Rules:

1. This show is held in strict accordance with the latest and revised Official Show Rules of the American Rabbits Breeders Assn. Inc.
2. All rabbits must be permanently and legibly marked in the left ear prior to showing. An ARBA licensed registrar will be available.
3. Exhibitors are responsible to make sure their rabbits are taken to the judging area when called & to remove the animal from the table at the completion of judging. Absolutely no refund of entry fees will be made. No classes will be re-judged.
4. Awards must be picked up the day of the show. Legs are mailed within 30 days of the show.
5. All animals must be healthy and in proper size transport cages to ensure rabbits well-being.
6. The RCRBA, its officers & the National Orange Show are not liable for any injury or damage in connection with the show. All rabbits are entered at the owner's risk. Judges & show committee are not in any way responsible for injury/death but every precaution will be taken for their safety.
7. Exhibitors must clean their area when leaving; otherwise a fine may be imposed. Keep your entry fees down by helping us keep a clean show facility. This is one of the last locations in Southern California. Please pick up your trash and debris!!!!
8. All exhibitors showing WOOLED BREEDS will be required to clean up after themselves.
9. This is a NO COMMENT CARD RABBIT SHOW . Cavy exhibitors will have comment cards!!!
10. RCRBA reserves the right to refuse entry to anyone. RCRBA also reserves the right to add or change any Judge.
11. According to ARBA rules an exhibitor cannot make any comments which may identify ownership of a rabbit, nor may they attempt to influence the judging of an animal. Anyone doing this may have their animal disqualified and removed from the show.
12. Aisles must be kept clear. Please do not block other exhibitors' spaces or pathways to show tables. The building is Huge there is room for all!
13. NO animals (except rabbit & cavies) allowed in the showroom. Exception - service animals under protection of the American Disabilities Act.
14. NO SMOKING IN SHOWROOM, NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES on grounds.
15. No selling of items or animals (rabbits & cavies excluded) neither outside nor inside building unless booth fee is paid, \$50
16. Changes day of show entries will be allowed at \$5.00 per rabbit per show. Ear changes will be allowed at the judging table for no charge. Any unauthorized changes that occur, will be considered a NO SHOW when the secretary completes final paperwork. THERE ARE NO EXCEPTIONS TO THIS RULE. It is up to the exhibitors' responsibility to complete changes and PAY prior to the breed being called to judging table.
17. Youth may not enter the same animal in both open and youth, but may enter different animals in open and youth.
18. All youth exhibitors must bring their animals to the table for judging. Adults are not allowed to bring animals entered in the youth show to the judging tables. Adults may assist youth members if they have multiple breeds.
19. Parents and/or acting guardians will be responsible for the conduct of their children. Inappropriate behavior, disrespect of animals, property or persons will result in dismissal from this show and forfeiture of all entry fees.
20. Once entry has been received the entry fee is due! Even if you are unable to attend, the funds need to be paid. Failure to pay the fees will result in you being banned from all RCRBA shows until the balance is paid. Late fees may be applied to your balance if an extended period of time passes.
***Any issue arising that cannot be resolved by reference to the above rules shall be decided by the official show committee, whose decision will be final. The show committee shall decide any and all questions arising which are not covered by specific rules. Upon submitting an entry the exhibitor agrees to abide by all show rules. ***
