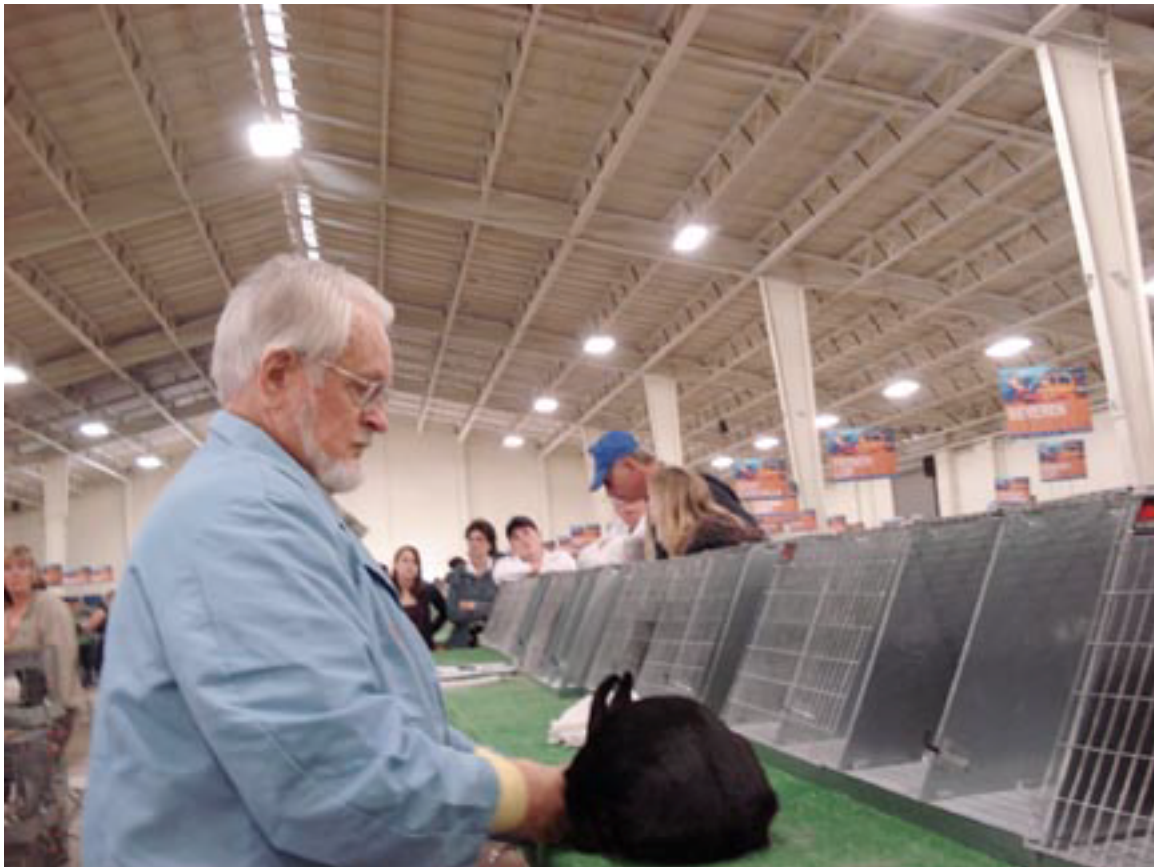

Judging begins promptly at **9 am**.

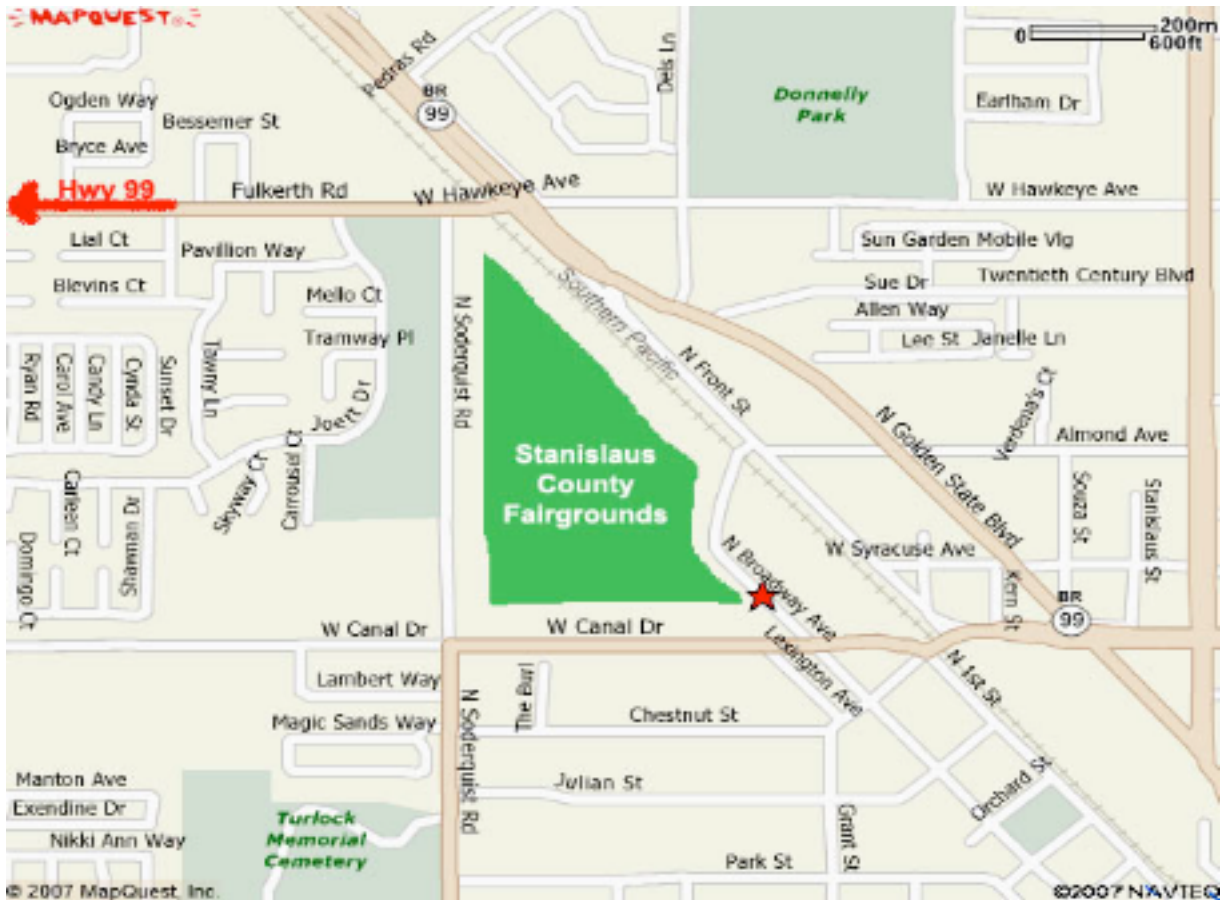
1. Entry Fees - Open and Youth Rabbit and Cavy Shows

5. All fees owed must be paid before the start of the show or the CSRCBA reserves the right to revoke your entries! All e-mail entries must be paid in full upon arrival to the show, should you not attend, you will be billed for your entry fee.
5. Bad Checks maybe liable for up to three times the amount of the check, minimum charge \$35.00 to cover expenses. \*If you enter via e-mail, money is still due even if you don't attend the show.
6. Collect calls will be made to all exhibitors with incomplete entry information.

## Show Rules

1. This show will be governed by the latest ARBA rules. Your entry indicates your acceptance of these rules.
2. All rabbits are entered at the owners' risk. Every precaution will be taken to safeguard and minimize hazards, losses and mistakes. Show personnel, judges and the Turlock County Fairgrounds are in no way responsible for death or injury to any animal.
3. Exhibitors will be responsible for getting their rabbits to and from the judging table. Exceptions will be for persons assisting with the show and CSRCBA will insure their rabbits get to the table as long as they advise CSRCBA in advance. There will be no re-judging due to late or missing rabbits per ARBA Show Rules!
4. All rabbits must be permanently and legibly marked in their left ear.
5. Ear changes will be allowed the day of the show at the table for same class, sex, variety only. The exhibitor is responsible to make sure changes are made to the card and clerk sheet.
7. All legs will be mailed. All specials and awards must be picked up at the show.
8. **Parents and guardians are responsible for the actions of their children. In order to prevent destruction to the fairground during the rabbit show, you will be responsible for paying any damage. Please keep your children inside the show area and controlled at all times.**
9. Sale rabbits must be a minimum of eight (8) weeks of age as per law. Please, only rabbits, cavies and service dogs allowed in the show building.
10. Any and all help will be greatly appreciated with setting up, during show and tearing down the show.
